

## FROM (GRU) GUARULHOS AIRPORT TO IFT-UNESP

### BY TRAIN PLUS SUBWAY (METRO)

This is the cheapest option, which costs R\$4,40 (around 1.00USD total). The Express train leaves every hour on the hour (5 am, 6 am, etc) and the Express train takes 30 minutes from the airport station to the Barra Funda station.

First you need to take a shuttle bus from the airport terminal you arrived at to the train station. GRU Airport offers free shuttle buses between the Terminals and the train station. Shuttle buses have the airport's identification and stop at the arrival level of the terminals, at the sidewalk outside. Standby time is up to 15 minutes. Transfer opening hours are from 04:00am to 00:00am. Look for information indications as below:

### At the train station

#### EXPRESS TRAIN

Take the escalators, buy your tickets (it costs BRL 4,40 – around one dollar) and go to the platform of the Express train. The ticket office accepts only Brazilian reais (BRL).

The train leaves on the hour and will stop in four stations: Guarulhos – CECAP, Brás, Luz and Palmeiras-Barra Funda. Get off at the last one (Palmeiras-Barra Funda station).

#### IFT-UNESP ARRIVAL (Palmeiras-Barra Funda station)

Follow the signs to the exit which is called “Av. Marquês de São Vicente”. After passing

through the turnstiles, turn left and walk until the end of the station building. There, go down the stairs on your right, or turn left to take the ramp. You will see immediately a large white and blue building across the street in front of you. The white and blue building is the Instituto de Artes, and next to it is a large white and green building which is the Instituto de Física Teórica. Enter in the gate between the two buildings and from the green building go to the 4th floor.



### BY EXECUTIVE BUS SERVICE

By Airport Bus Service, as you walk outside the terminal, you will see immediately a line of buses - the Airport Bus Service. The bus fare costs around R\$40,00 (approximately 8 USD), and near the buses there is a ticket office. Each bus has its destination noted on the front or side. The destination you have to take is “Barra Funda” and it takes about 1-2 hours, depending on the traffic. Check the link for bus schedules: <https://www.airportbusservice.com.br/>



When you arrive at Barra Funda, take the escalators. After the escalator, turn your left and go to the end of the station building. There, go down the stairs on your right, or turn left to take the ramp. You will see immediately a large white and blue building across the street in front of you. The white and blue building is the Instituto de Artes, and next to it is a large white and green building which is the Instituto de Física Teórica. Enter in the gate between the two buildings and from the green building go to the 4th floor.



### **BY TAXI**

As you get out of the terminal, you will see buses and taxi companies, there is a company called Guarucop (which we recommend). It is on the sidewalk just outside the airport and you can pay with credit card. The ride from the airport to IFT-UNESP will cost around 150 Brazilian reais (approximately 30USD). IFT-UNESP address is: Rua Jornalista Aloysio Biondi, 120 – Barra Funda – São Paulo. The trip should take 40-100 minutes depending on the traffic.



### **BY UBER**

If you have a mobile phone, use the GRU airport wi-fi to request an Uber. The ride from the airport to IFT-UNESP will vary from 70-150 Brazilian reais (approximately 15-30 USD). IFT-UNESP address is: Rua Jornalista Aloysio Biondi, 120 – Barra Funda – São Paulo. The trip should take 40-100 minutes depending on the traffic.
